2. Venue of the Counselling and Admission:

3. How to reach the venue:

- From Howrah: Hazra by bus- then by auto-St. Lawrence High School stop (opposite footpath)
- From Sealdah: Ballygunge Phanri by bus- then by auto-St. Lawrence High School stop (opposite footpath)
- From Sealdah: Padmapukur (Near Minto Park, Sarat Bose Road) by bus then by walking.
- From Ballygunge Station: Deshopriya Park by auto- and then Padmapukur (Near Minto Park, Sarat Bose Road) by bus- then by auto- St. Lawrence High School stop (opposite footpath)
- From Esplanade. Hazra by bus /Metro- and then by auto- St. Lawrence High School stop (opposite footpath)

4. Documents to be produced at the time of Counselling and Admission:

- Candidates must submit self-attested photocopies of the original documents. The original documents are required to be produced at the time of counselling and admission. Documents(in original) to be produced are:

- ✓ Certificates in support of reservation/fee-reduction/ exemption

- Candidates having D. EL. Ed. are required to submit their final year undergraduate degree result and certificate.
- The candidate who has appeared in the final semester of the eligibility qualification must have to submit their admit card of the final semester examination and also to submit the pass marksheet of the preceding semester examinations.

5. Instruction to candidates:

Candidates are instructed to follow all previous notices (including addendum/corrigendum). It is the responsibility of the candidates to ensure eligibility criteria for applying. A candidate who fails to fulfil the eligibility criteria for admission on the basis of valid documents will be refused counselling and admission.

6. Fees to be deposited on the day of Counselling:

- The selected candidates will have to deposit **Rs. 5000/-** (to the respective college in which admission is being taken) in cash on spot on the day of counselling for seat-booking and the rest of the course fee to be paid to the respective college at the time of actual admission. The programme fee will be as per G.O. No. 488– Edn (CS) /10M-20/2015 Dated Kolkata, the 25th April, 2018 (available in the university website in the column of Latest News).
- In addition to the above all the candidates will have to pay **Rs. 1000.00** in cash to the University on the day of counselling as the counselling fee.
